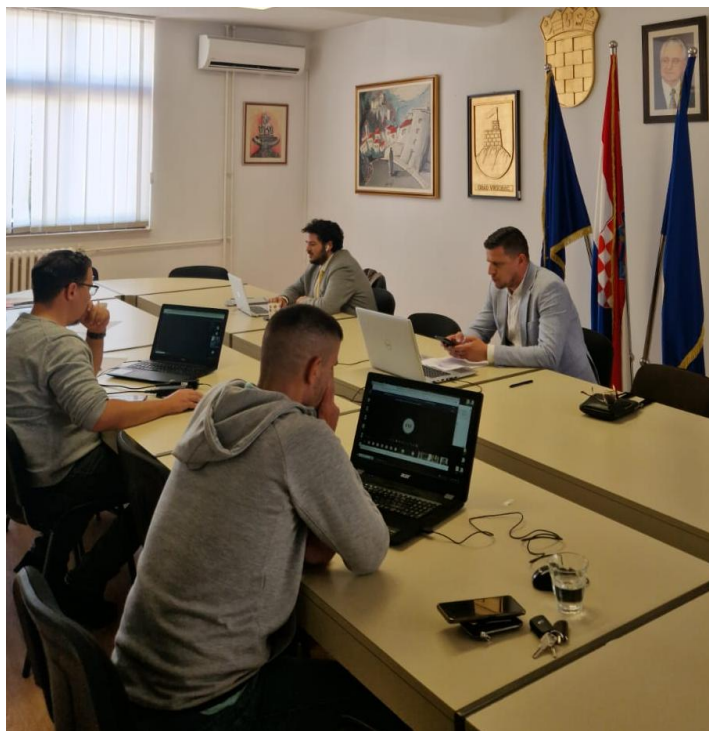

On 12th of May, the initial part of the online meeting was to set the goal and involve more than 101 participants, introduce them with new perspective and knowledge of good practice of this project and good local practice that is explained above. Since some of the partners enjoyed us for the first time (Kostrzyn in Poland), we want to introduce them with Municipality of Vrgorac, to get more information and details before we continue with further steps. Mr. Mile Herceg, Mayor of Vrgorac, started the Conference by welcoming all participants. Following, Mr. Francesco Marchionni, on behalf of Municipality of Capizzone, presented the EURebirth Project “Strategic and human rebirth in European local communities”.

Afterward, Francesco starts the Project Coordination Meeting by presenting the agenda for the day and the main aspects to be discussed, presented in details the EURebirth Project “Strategic and human rebirth in European local communities”. EURebirth emerged after Covid-19, as a mean to transform its negative effects into positive and beneficial situations for the community: how to be reborn. One of the main issues the communities face, and one of the key aspects of the project, is youth involvement. Through them, the project intends to transform society by enhancing equality, promoting the exchange between citizens of different European countries, fostering the values and knowledge of cultural heritage. Participants were introduced with roadmap of this project and Francesco mention how its recognized and ***selected again*** and further as a **Good Practice** and, as such, will be **presented** within the **Official Program** of the **21st Edition** of

the **European Week of Regions and Cities 2023** (the *most important European Event* dedicated to the **Cohesion Policy** of the **European Union**). To achieve this objective, EURebirth introduces the creation of an observatory, with the aim to discover the impact that the Covid-19 pandemic had into the citizenship, as well as an innovative methodology that is based on a circular model where the feedback from citizens is considered and integrated into the development of new policies.

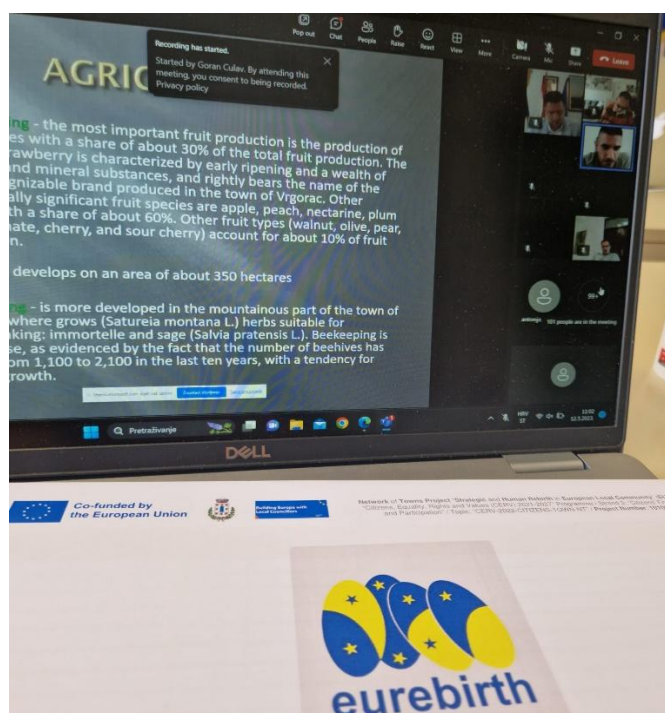

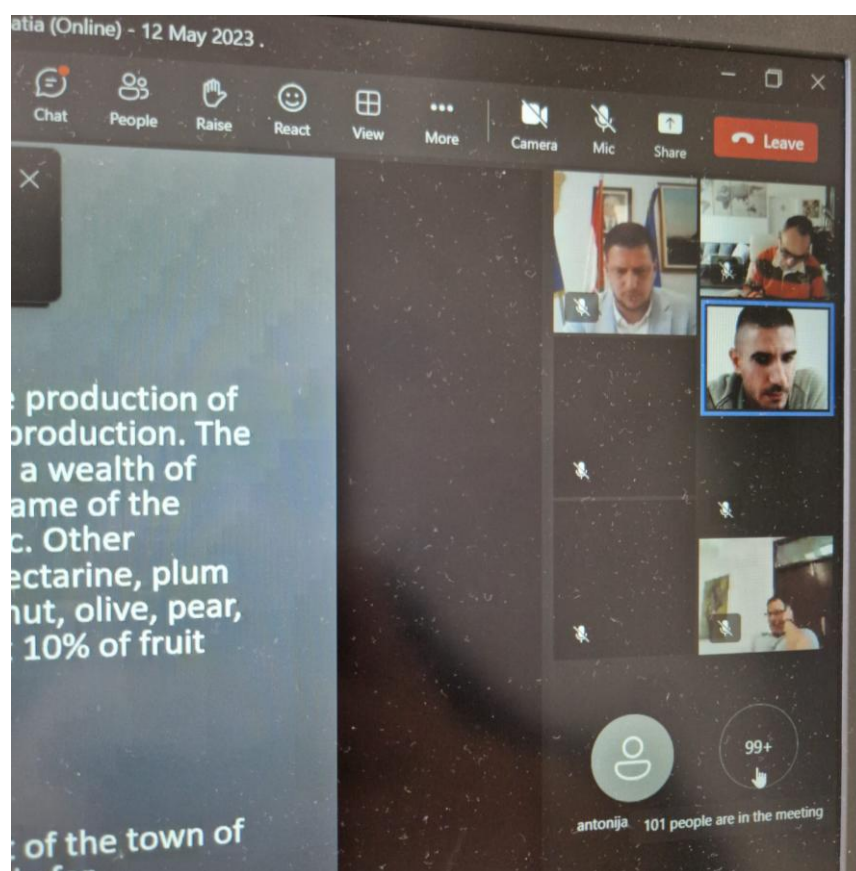
12th of May – City Hall, Online meeting - Teo Dodig present the Project “Kupuj domaće”, a good practice on agriculture development and mobility financed by the Municipality of Vrgorac.

On the 12th of May 2023, the Municipality of Vrgorac organized online meeting where the agenda was to introduce the partners and local community with a good practice on sustainable development in the whole region and more, with project named “Think globally, buy locally”. The presentation and project were presented

by developer and coordinator Mr. Teo Dodig from Entrepreneur center in Vrgorac. Effects of this project provide new jobs in the field of storage, transport, and delivery. Agriculture was the priority and they wanted to mobilize the agriculture in Vrgorac from worker to buyer since this is one of the main economic aspects in municipality. This project is a platform for the placement of agricultural products on the domestic market, but project is initially oriented towards larger buyers because it is realistically about large quantities, and certain development of accompanying activities in which private persons and entrepreneurs can be found, such as, for example, organized transport of goods to consumers after combining several offers ("from the ground to the door" service).



Then there may be an interest in investing in cold storage and storage facilities with the aim of possibly delaying placement and waiting for more favorable conditions/prices. Joining other cities and municipalities to our project, the possibility of joining our platform and are willing to share our knowledge and experience with everyone, to help Croatian agriculture together. Concerning Rebirth when facing the Covid-19 pandemic, Teo explains that, even though it was a challenge, it helped their business evolve even more. When dealing with buyers, they developed a web and mobile phone App for them to manage their purchase without having to have direct contact with producer.

Looking back, Teo states that during that time their sales increased in comparison with the years before (the project started 2 years before pandemic). The challenges faced by rural communities within this matter are related to mobility (lack of transport connections) and the disengagement of the youth in the economic activities of the territory. Partners point that

some of the means to deal with these challenges are to create career opportunities (such as this app and website) for the young population within the Municipality, develop policies that enhance the economy of the rural territory and to increase digital education for the attractiveness and facilitate access to the new generations.
